How to use the IRLP Node 6095 set up on 438.700mhz Whangarei Repeater

438.700mhz - 5mz split

- First make sure you have the CTCSS activated on your radio for this frequency using a tone of 123 hz
- Check the repeater is not being used. Announce your call sign saying you will be using the IRLP repeater.
- Key the transmitter and from your DTMF keypad on your transceiver enter the 4 digit number of the node you wish to connect to.
- If connection is successful you will be notified via a voice prompt.
- After you have finished using the IRLP Repeater from your DTMF keypad on your transceiver enter 73 to disconnect the node. Use your call sign as you would normally with any QSO.
